



NOTICE OF RACE

13th Annual Wild Turkey Classic Plastic

Sat. Nov. 25th, 2017

Hosted by Ventura Sailing Club

Attention...

Attention all sailboat racers – time to work off the turkey dinner by entering the 13th annual Wild Turkey Classic Plastic. This year, this pursuit race, which is a favorite with racers, is open to all race boats. Those with a PHRF certificate will receive High Points for the championship. But to qualify for the Classic Plastic perpetual, your boat must be older than 1997.

THE ENTRY: The race is open to all racers, whether they are members of a yacht club or not. The entry fee is \$30 for non-Ventura Sailing Club members and \$20 for VSC members. (\$5 discount for USSA members).

THE COURSE: The Starting Line will be set on the outside of the C.I. Harbor N. entrance. A random leg course of approximately 15 miles, depending on conditions, will be chosen on race day. The finish line will be between the innermost navigational lights on the north and south jetties of the CI Harbor.

THE RULES: The race will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing. The Sailing Instructions will be passed out at the mandatory Captains' Meeting to be held at the AYC clubhouse. It will be a pursuit style race, with the slowest boats starting first and starting times based on handicap. Sign-ups will be accepted from 8:00-8:45. Captains' meeting will be from 8:45-9:00. First start will be at 11:00.

THE CLASSES: PHRF-handicapped 60's, 70's, and 80's non-spinnaker classes; w/ spinnaker, post 96' Monohull, Beachcat, and ORCA classes to be determined as needed before the race.

All boats welcome to race!

HARDWARE FOR THE MANTLE: Trophies/prizes will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place boats in each class w/ a minimum of 5 boats, as well as for the overall PHRF non-spinnaker winner of the 60's – 96' "Plastic Classics". Please meet at the AYC clubhouse after the race for results, story-telling, food, etc. The official awards ceremony will take place in the VSC Clubhouse (upstairs at the Victoria Pub and Grill) at 6:30 pm on Tues. December 12th.
